Selection Process

- At all times the Selection Committee's intention shall be to select the team capable of winning each game.
- The Selection Committee members shall meet and/or correspond amongst themselves regularly throughout the season in order to monitor performance of players in NSCA/Halifax League games.
- The Team Nova Scotia Captain and or Coach may be consulted relating to team selection, but shall not have any direct input on players who should be selected.
- For inter-provincial games, selections of Team Nova Scotia shall be completed by the Selection Committee not later than the Sunday evening of the weekend preceding the fixture, and submitted to the NSCA Board for ratification of eligibility. Selected players shall be advised either via e-mail or telephone of their selection and of the necessary arrangements (where applicable).
- Any replacements required for players selected who are not available shall be selected by the committee in a timely manner.
- All NSCA players shall be required to advise the Selection Committee of their unavailability for any inter-provincial fixtures not later than the Friday of two weekend's preceding the fixture.
- Where there is an issue over a player's inclusion or exclusion for Team Nova Scotia between the Co-Selectors, the Chairman of the Selection Committee shall hold the deciding vote.

Criteria

 - i) Attitude
 - ii) Dedication/Commitment
 - iii) Form/Results/Potential/History
 - iv) Team Balance
 - v) Conduct
 - vi) Fitness
 - vii) Financial Status with NSCA

- The aim of the Selection Committee shall be to select what we consider the best team from the players available for selection at all times based on a combination of these General Criteria.
- It should be noted that whilst the Selection Committee will endeavour to achieve consistency in the selection process, a certain amount of subjective judgement by the Selection Committee shall always be required.
